Voter Experience Survey – League of Women Voters WI

Our great partners at the LWVWI have put together a voter experience survey for the November 3rd election. This is a place where voters can tell us about their experience voting - absentee, early voting, or in person on Election Day - and can let us know about issues they faced or good things they'd like to see replicated in other parts of the state. The information we collected from voters after the April Election was invaluable and allowed us to be more effective as we advocated for improvements to the other 2020 elections.

This survey is open to all Wisconsin voters, and also addresses accessibility concerns. The SABE survey which we also promote is limited to voters with disabilities.

SABE GoVoter Experience Survey

Reminder to Voters with disabilities: take the SABE GoVoter Experience Survey. SABE stands for Self-Advocates Being Empowered – the SABE survey is specific to voters who have a disability. The SABE GoVoter survey helps us learn more about what is working well for voters with disabilities and what are the challenges. The Disability Vote Coalition will use the survey results to advocate with elected officials to make improvements to our voting system.
